



Mapping Suaahara II to SEEMS typology



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
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Mapping Suaahara II to SEEMS typology



Methods





Financial vs. Economic Costs

Financial

- What are the actual annualized expenses paid by the Suaahara II project?
 - Salaries, materials, vehicles and transport, infrastructure, etc.
 - Source:
 - Consortium partner expenditures
 - PNGO expenditures


Economic

- What are the value of resources provided by Suaahara II government and community partners (including beneficiaries)?
 - Opportunity cost of time
 - Out-of-pocket cost
 - Source:
 - Interviews and focus groups



Sampling

- Districts
 - Purposively sampled
 - Nawalparasi, Sindhupalchok, Bhajang, Dhading
- Municipalities
 - Purposively sampled from Suaahara II Annual Survey clusters
 - One rural municipality, one municipality
- Wards
 - Randomly sampled from Suaahara II Annual Survey clusters



Qualitative Data Collection

- National level:
 - 1-4 staff members per consortium partner
 - 1 financial staff per consortium partner
- District level:
 - Suaahara II Coordinator and Technical officers (5)
 - PNGO Field Coordinator and AFO (2)
 - Field supervisors (5-8), CNVs (10-15), VMFs (5-8)
- Municipality level:
 - Municipal health coordinator, nutrition coordinator, NFSSC members (2)
- Ward level:
 - Front-line HCWs (3-4), FHCVs (6-9)
 - 1000-day mothers (5-10)



Financial Expenditure Data

- Expense-level records from national consortium partners and district-level implementing organizations
- Coded by input and activity
 - Staff time and shared costs allocated to activities using interview data
- Start-up and capital expenses annualized

*Qualitative interviews have been completed in all districts except Bajhang. Data collection is delayed in Bajhang due to COVID-19 restrictions.











Annual economic cost by district and activity
