Visa Information

All foreign nationals require a visa to enter India and should be in possession of a valid passport with no less than 6 months validity. There are several types of visa available but participants travelling specifically for the 4th ANH Academy Week will need to apply for a **Conference Visa** either [online](#) or in Indian embassy or mission in their country of residence.

If you require a visa to attend the conference and you will need an invitation letter for your visa application, we can provide you with one if you follow the steps below. Please check the embassy or mission in your country of residence for more information about the visa application process and required documents.

The Process

- Register for ANH Academy Week on our [website](#). Registration opens initially on 18th of March
- When completing your registration please tick the box to indicate that you need a visa to enter India and provide your name as it appears in your passport
- We will then send you the invitation letter and other supporting documents once we get the necessary clearance from government of India (likely to be 30-40 days before the event)
- You will then be able to apply for a conference visa either online or at the Indian Embassy in your country of residence

If there is no Indian embassy or mission where you live, it may be possible for you to obtain a conference e-visa online. Please contact us to discuss this further – ANH-Academy@lshtm.ac.uk

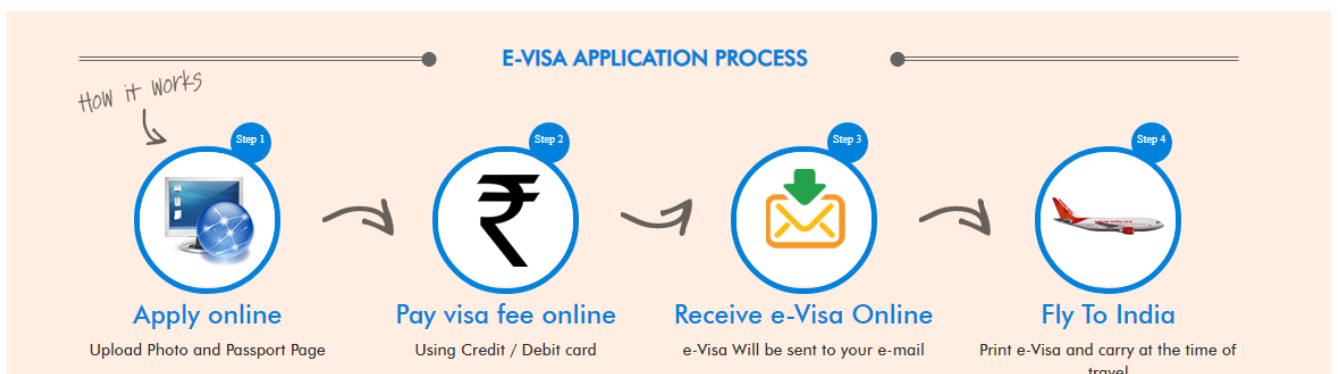

Please note: To hold this event in India, the ANH Academy must go through several layers of clearance with the Government of India. We have now secured the clearance from the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) and will now need to seek clearance from the Ministry of External Affairs to issue invitation letters to each specific participant. We expect to receive this within 30-40 days of the event. As soon as we have this we will send you the invitation letter and all the necessary supporting documents to help you with your visa application as and when we get this clearance. Please see the diagram below which outlines the process.

Requirement for a conference visa application at Indian Embassy

- Passport valid for 6 months with at least two blank pages
- Visa application forms to be completed and signed
- Correct visa fee
- Two recent 50mm * 50mm size photographs. Please check the photo specification with the Indian embassy of your respective country
- A copy of support letter from your organisation
- A copy of the signed letter of Invitation for the conference from our local partners in India
- A copy of another invitation letter from ANH Academy
- A copy of event clearance letters from Government of India
- Please note that this list is not exhaustive and participants are advised to check with the embassy or mission in their country of residence for more information about required documents.
